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## **Seven Reasons to Choose SBDHS:**

1. Low teacher to student ratios – average class size at SBDHS is 20 – 25 students. This enables our teachers to provide more time and attention to each student depending on their individual learning needs.
2. University courses – SBDHS' **University Now** program permits students to complete first-year university Calculus, Applied Computer Science and English courses while still in high school. Our **University Now** course fees are lower than standard University rates.
3. 100% University acceptance – SBDHS graduates maintain a high level of acceptance into university and college programs.
4. Faith-based learning and programs – Catholic values and spirituality are integral components of the SBDHS curriculum and students have access to many Campus Ministry programs including Bible study and discussions groups, holiday services and observances, and prayer groups. Our ministry is located on campus.
5. Student support – SBDHS offers many on-campus student support services including personal counselling, academic and career planning, self -development, school transitioning and **PSSST** which is a confidential link for students facing crisis, bullying and other stresses and challenges.
6. Extra-curricular activities – in addition to our sports programs SBDHS offers many rewarding activities including foreign trips, Dragon Boat racing, charity work, a computer coding club, choir and much more.
7. SBDHS isn't just a school, it's a family where students develop friendships and memories that last a lifetime.
